

## **ARCHITA**

On 08<sup>th</sup> June, 2015 Joga Rao, R/o Dairy Farm came to PS Aberdeen and reported that on 06/06/2015 at 0930hrs his wife Smti. P.Rekha aged 19 years along with his one year old daughter namely Archita went to G.B.Pant Hospital and did not return to his home till date. Further, he informed that his wife is having a illicit relation with one Pratap of dairy Farm and might have fled away with him.

During enquiry it revealed that a missing lady along with her daughter is at Visakapatnam. However, this fact was entered in the General Diary vide entry No. 32 of Police Station Aberdeen on 08/06/18 at 1000hrs. Later, Shri Joga Rao informed PS Aberdeen that he had spoken to his wife over phone. They were safe and shall return to Port Blair soon. On this Shri Joga Rao was asked to report the matter to PS Aberdeen soon after the arrival of his wife and daughter from mainland.

On 13/07/2015, Shri Joga Rao came to PS Aberdeen along with his wife Smti. P.Rekha and daughter Baby Archita. Accordingly, necessary entry about tracing of the missing child has been made in the General Dairy of PS Aberdeen Entry No. 40 at 1300hrs on 13/7/15.

### **MISS. ROJA (age-8yrs)**

On 13/10/11 Teppala Appanna S/o. Kamaiah R/o. Dairy Farm, Port Blair lodged a report at Police Station Aberdeen, regarding missing of his daughter Smt. (30) yrs. W/o. Shri. D. Tejeshwar Rao and his grand-daughter (daughter's daughter) **Miss. Roja (Renu) (8)yrs.** Subsequently, an enquiry was conducted which revealed that on 13/10/11 the aforesaid missing lady alongwith her 8 yrs daughter Miss. Roja (Renu) left from Port Blair to Chennai by M.V. Nicobar ship. All efforts were made to trace out the missing lady and child but, no fruitful result found. Later, on 20/08/13 the instant missing report was converted into FIR vide crime No. 207/13 dated 20/08/13 U/s. 363 IPC at PS Aberdeen on the directive of the Hon'ble Supreme Court's order No. 105/13 passed in the matter of Writ Petition being WP (C) No. 75 of 2012 (Bachpan Bachao Aandolan Vs Union of India & Others ) since a minor girl child was involved in the instant missing case. During investigation and from the statement of the concerned witnesses it revealed that, the missing lady had an extra marital affair with one Veera Bhardra Rao and she alongwith her daughter had eloped with said Shri. Veera Bhardra. During further investigation on contact through a mobile No. 7406175744, received from brother of Veera Bhardra, he disclosed that the missing lady Smti. Susheela and her daughter Miss. Roja (Renu) are safe and are under his custody. The Investigating Officer also talked with the missing lady and recorded her voice. They disclosed that they were at Bangalore. Thereafter the said mobile No. was permanently disconnected. To trace out the missing persons a Hue & Cry Notice was issued to all the states but no fruitful information was received. However, as far as the minor child is concerned her own mother who is the lawful guardian of the child had taken the said child alongwith her on her own for ensuring effective safe custody and protection of her own child. And the above instant case was submitted final report before the court.

Further, as per the direction of superior officer and during the campaign of 'Operation smile' the search operation of the missing child

was conducted but, in vain. Again during OPERATION MUSKAAN brother of Veera Bhardra, Shri, Krishna was called. During interrogation, Shri. Krishna disclosed that a friend of his brother, namely Shri. Laxman, recently came to Port Blair and that he knows the details of Veera Bhardra. Subsequently Shri. Laxman R/o. Haddo was called and interrogated. He disclosed that since Jan, 2015 he was working with Veera Bhardra at Banglore and that the missing lady Smti. Susheela and her child Roja are also staying with him happily.

The detail address was collected from Shri Laxman i.e. No. 8-11-181, 716, Vidya Nagar - Vill, Raichur, Karnataka- Dist. This address was immediately sent to Inspector Sanjay Kumar SHO PS Aberdeen, who was in Chennai for investigation in another case.

Inspector Sanjay on receipt of the address, proceeded to Bangalore and traced out the missing lady and the girl child Roja (Renu) with the help of Karnataka local police. The missing lady Susheela and daughter are staying happily with Veera Bhardra. On this a GD Entry has been made at Nathaji Nagar Police Station Raichur.
