

**POLICE CONSTABLE SAVES ONE PRECIOUS LIFE AT
CHATHAM JETTY**

On 20.10.2016 at about 2220 hrs, a call was received at PS Chatham from PCR regarding drowning of a person at Chatham Jetty. On this, Police party of PS Chatham immediately rushed to the spot where they found that a man was drowning and struggling to find the shore which was about 25-30 mtrs away from the Chatham jetty. On seeing him, PC/1154 Gaius James of PS Chatham, immediately jumped into the sea and reached the victim and rescued him and saved his life and (the victim) immediately shifted to GB Pant Hospital where he was admitted and who is now out of danger.

On enquiry the victim disclosed his name as Prem Ram Bhudhwa, S/o Late Dharam Ram, R/o Padauk Bagicha, Manarghat and further stated that on 20/10/2016 he had come to Aberdeen bazaar for personal work and reached Chatham Jetty about 2200 hrs to return to his house for Bambooflat. As the ferry vehicle had already left and he was waiting at Chatham Jetty, he suddenly slipped and fell into the sea.

Prompt action was thus taken by PC/1154 Gaius James of PS Chatham to save the life of Prem Ram Budhwa S/o Late Dharam Ram(45) yrs R/o Padauk Bagicha, Manarghat.
