

RESCUE OPERATION BY A & N POLICE FIRE SERVICE

On 6/6/2016 at about 0634 hrs a Special Service Call was received from Police Control Room that a house had collapsed at Haddo village, Port Blair. Immediately Fire personnel of Fire Station Chatham alongwith Water Tender AN 01 C 0127 rushed to the scene of occurrence. On reaching the spot, it was noticed that the Toilet block of the house had deracinated from the land due to heavy rain and derailed towards steep slope and in a lady was trapped. There was no scope for the girl to get off from the toilet block on her own as the situation was so dangerous it was entangling towards the deep slope where a number of residential houses were located. Immediately, rescue operation by Fire Brigade was started using cutting and lifting tools. Keeping in view rains and delicate situation, assistance of Rescue Tender and staff from Fire Station Aberdeen were also requisitioned and the rescue operation was carried out by the officers and staff of Fire Station Aberdeen and Chatham cautiously considering the risk to life and property as there was every possibility of sliding of land due to heavy rains. Due to the earnest efforts of the staff, girl namely Miss. Jayalaxmi aged 22 years, a student of MCA was rescued safely without any injury. As a result of prompt action the A & N Police Fire Service could save the precious life and property.
