**SOUTH ANDAMAN POLICE NABS A GANG INVOLVED  
IN VEHICLE THEFT**

South Andaman Police has cracked three cases of theft with the apprehension of three persons and seized 02 Motor cycles and 01 music system.

On the complaint of Shri Satish Kumar, Junglighat, Port Blair, a case vide Crime No. 307/2017 U/s 379 IPC was registered at PS Aberdeen against unknown accused persons regarding theft of music system from his vehicle Maruti Omni parked near Junglighat CCS on 25/06/2017. Another case vide crime No.308/17 U/s 379 IPC was also registered at PS Aberdeen on the complaint of Shri. Ameet J Arora, M/S Yugesh General Stores, Supply Lane, Aberdeen Bazaar regarding theft of his motor cycle Bajaj Pulsar from opposite of Hotel Corel Cove, Minnie Bay.

Upon this, the special team of PS Aberdeen consisting of HC Vijay Shankar, HC V. Hentho, PC Abdul Rasheed, PC Ashok Kumar, PC Suresh PC Shiv Kumar and PC Jugdish Babu headed by Inspr. A. K. Singh, SHO PS Aberdeen put strenuous efforts and succeeded in apprehending one suspect namely Jaganath Lakra (36) yrs. R/o Gupta Para who during interrogation accepted his guilt and revealed that on the intervening night of 29/06/17, he alongwith another two juveniles had stolen the motor cycle bearing Regn. No.AN01/D-9762 from Minnie Bay and the music system (Sony) from the Omni bearing Regn. No.AN01 E-0393. Further one more vehicle bearing Regn. No.AN01/F-2448 owned by Shri. Shaukat Ali R/o Ograbraj was also recovered from them. Further investigations of the cases is in progress.

The team has worked extremely hard in cracking these cases and put tremendous & skilled efforts in their assigned duties under the supervision of SDPO (SA) Shri. Nishant Gupta. The general public is requested to share information with police so that such anti-social elements are brought to justice and they may pass such information on 100 (PCR) or respective Police Station on 03192-232400 (PS Aberdeen), 03192-250525 (PS Pahargaon), and 03192-232232 (PS Chatham).
