44 IRBn personnel, their family members & NDRF personnel stationed at IRBn HQ were screened and their blood samples were collected for further examination. The health awareness visual were also shown in the camp to sensitize jawans to refrain themselves from consumption of alcohol, smoking and chewing of tobacco.
