STANDING ORDER NO. - 5985

PROCEDURE FOR SELECTION TO THE POST OF CONSTABLE (BANDS MAN)
AND (BUGLER) IN ANDAMAN & NICOBAR POLICE

The Recruitment Rule for the post of Constable (Bands Man) and (Bugler) of A&N Police has been notified vide A&N Administration Notification F. No.7-11/2002-Home dated 28th June, 2010.

The post of Constable (Bands Man) & (Bugler) in A&N Police will be filled 100% by direct recruitment.

1. ELIGIBILITY & PROCEDURE:

a)	Age limit (The Crucial date for determining the age limit shall be the closing date for receipt of names/applications from employment Exchange/candidate.)	i) Male: 18-25 years for General, 18 to 28 years for OBC and 18 to 30 ST candidates ii) Female: 18-30 years for General, 18 to 33 years for OBC and 18 to 35 for ST candidates iii) (Relaxable upto 5 years for Govt. servant in accordance with the instructions/orders issued by GOI)

2. PHYSICAL ENDURANCE TEST

The candidates who qualify after physical measurement shall undergo a physical endurance test as per the following standards.

Male	Female
a) 1 mile race (to be completed in 8 minutes 30 Seconds)	a) Half mile race (to be completed in 5 minutes).
b) 3.5 feet High Jump (3 chances will be given)	b) 3 feet High Jump (3 chances will be given).
c) 10 feet Long Jump (3 chances will be given).	c) 8 feet Long Jump (3 chances will be given).

3. CONSTITUTION OF SELECTION BOARD: -

A Selection Board consisting of DIGP/SP as Chairman, two GO's of A&N Police & one gazetted officer from another department as members shall be constituted by the Director General of Police for conducting the recruitment test. Selection Board can also co-opt a specialist with the prior approval of the Director General of Police, A&N Islands to gauge the suitability of the candidate.

4. WRITTEN EXAMINATION

The candidates who qualify in Physical Measurement and Physical Endurance Test will undergo a written test. The paper will be set both in English and Hindi. Candidates will have the option of answering in either language except for the portion of language paper, which will contain questions on Hindi and English both.

The question papers will cover general knowledge, reasoning, simple arithmetic, test of language and essay and will carry 40 marks.

5. INTERVIEW

The candidates who qualify in the written test will be subjected to an interview of 20 marks by a selection board. During the interview the overall personality, aptitude, attitude, general awareness and suitability for the job of the candidates will be judged. Further the competence in playing of musical instruments used for marching band of Police will be judged and accordingly 40 marks will be awarded for playing the following instrument of his choice.

1. Keyboard (Piano harmonium electrical key board)
 2. Guitar
 3. Acto Pad (Percussion)
 4. Clarinet
 5. Trumpet
 6. Percussion (drums) Instruments
 7. Any other instruments required subsequently

8. Ability to read and play music from musical score sheet - 10 Marks

6. Medical Standards:


The successful candidates shall be subjected to a medical examination as given below:-

- i) The minimum distant vision should be 6/6 and 6/9 of two eyes without correction i.e. without wearing glasses. The candidates should not have colour blindness.
- ii) The candidate must not have knock knee, flat foot, varicose vein, squint eyes, bow legs, inability to flex the fingers properly or any other obvious deformities.
- iii) Candidates must be in good mental and physical health and free from any physical defects likely to interfere with the efficient performance of police duties.

Appointment to the post shall be subject to successful completion of medical examination and Police verification report.

For matters not specified in this Standing Order, the decision of the Director General of Police, A & N Islands shall be final.
