CIRCULAR

As per existing transfer policy, the tenure of police personnel posted in Nicobar District is 300 days.

Requests are being received from the police personnel to continue in the Nicobar District beyond 300 days. It has been decided to consider such requests in the following manner-

- i. Police person willing to stay beyond 300 days in Nicobar District will be allowed to continue for another tenure (300 days) at the same Police Station.
- ii. Any subsequent request for extension to stay beyond two tenures (300 days each) will be considered on the basis of his/her performance but he/she will be adjusted in different Police Station in Nicobar District.
- iii. After completion of four years service in Nicobar District, the police personnel have to compulsorily move out from Nicobar District.

This is issued with the approval of the Director General of Police, Andaman and Nicobar Islands.
